

Paris-Charles de Gaulle and Paris-Orly: ideal locations for enhancing your cargo business

- Paris-Charles de Gaulle and Paris-Orly are Paris' gateway to France and beyond and the number one choice for Cargo in Europe.
- Paris-Charles de Gaulle airport, working 24/7, handles approximately 90% of France's freight.
- Strategically located 25 km north-east of Paris, the airport is served by first-rate road and rail allowing rapid access to the airport and on to other European cities.
- Paris-Orly airport, open from 6am to 11.30pm daily, lies adjacent to the Rungis Wholesale Market infrastructure and provides Phytosanitary controls.
- 24,000 foreign companies already based in France, confirm that Groupe ADP, with a catchment area of 25 million consumers, is Europe's key center for business.

In order to accompany and bring together all actors in the development of their cargo activity Groupe ADP supports CIN France: **Cargo Information Network.**

A highly efficient digital Cargo Community System, CIN expedites the processing of the cargo on the ground while improving its traceability. It makes these two Parisian platforms an even more attractive choice for new partners while giving support to its existing cargo businesses. Roughly 80% of the supply chain at both airports adheres to CIN France.

- With 12 local branches for customs and public services, administrative support is provided directly in the Cargo Area.
- Together with our customers and partners, Groupe ADP is directly involved in the digitalization process including action plans such as customs facilitation services with government representatives.
- OCAPI implementation:
 - Optimizing the fleet of equipment and improving management of cargo flows on the ground.
 - Combining traceability, geo-location and video protection.
 - Improving safety on the ground.

2016-2020: Connect 2020: Groupe ADP's commitment to Cargo operations with:

- Construction of 100,000 sq.m of terminal facilities between 2016 and 2020.
- New signage in cargo areas and monitoring of access to the cargo city.
- Organization of areas and streamlining of buildings.

2016: Bolloré Logistics new hub:

- 40,000 sq.m of buildings to consolidate Bolloré's air freight activities.

2015: Sodexi:

- A new express freight hub with a 7,600 sq.m warehouse close to aircraft parking stands.
- Air freight and mail management and processing flows.
- 55,000 metric tons in annual capacity.

2015: DHL Global Forwarding:


