**Nationwide air traffic controllers strike  
From Tuesday June 11 to Thursday June 13**

Due to a nationwide air traffic controllers strike between June 11 and 13, the French Civil Aviation Authority (DGAC) has requested airlines to reduce their flight schedules by half at Paris-Charles de Gaulle and Paris-Orly airports.

Air traffic to and from both airports may be heavily disrupted during the three days.

Aéroports de Paris recommend that travellers contact their airlines for more information and to make sure that their flight is scheduled before they get to the airport.

Aéroports de Paris staff are mobilized to inform and guide passengers.
